# Where in the world should Sunny live?

Where in the world should Sunny live? Our topic this term is based on the story of Meerkat Mail by Emily Gravett, we will be researching the climates of different continents around the world and identifying their physical features in order to find the ideal home for Sunny the Meerkat to live.

In Computing we will be word processing and learning about E-Safety.



In English we will be focusing on the text Meerkat Mail to help us to plan, write and edit our own text in a range of genres. This term we will be writing our own recounts, stories, poems and information texts. The skills we will be teaching are planning, writing, drafting, editing and reading aloud our work. Our grammar focus will include conjunctions, expanded noun phrases, present and past progressive verbs and we will learn about different sentence forms (statement, question, command, and exclamation).



In Maths we will be learning to add and subtract numbers using concrete objects, pictorial reps and mentally (incl 2 digit and ones, 2 digit and 10s, 3 one digit numbers). The children will solve simple problems involving addition, subtraction, and place value and number facts. We will continue onto simple multiplication and division using pictures, arrays, repeated addition/subtraction moving to formal methods.

In Geography we will be comparing where we live with other continents around the world. We will use maps and the globes to study what makes an area hot or cold and we will discuss the proximity some of the continents in relation to the equator. We will look at the weather of these continents as well as some of their physical features and the wildlife that can be found here.

In P.E we will be doing a dance unit based on Jungle Fever. We will learn how to repeat simple skills and actions with increasing control and coordination and perform a sequence. In Games children will refine skills for sending and receiving a ball.



In Science we will be learning about how to keep fit and healthy. We will be looking at exercise and discussing why it is important, as well as other factors which help us to grow and survive. We will be looking at the different food groups and will be discussing which foods are healthy and unhealthy.

In **R.E** we will be learning about Jesus' early life. We will be looking at Judaism and we will be researching other religious celebrations such as Hannukah.
