PARKING AROUND SCHOOL



Can we please remind parents when dropping or picking up their child for school, to park in a courteous manner. We have been made aware of parents causing obstructions to other road users. We have contacted the local PCSO and asked for help with this matter.

FIXED PENALTY NOTICE

We are required to remind parents that any request to take your child out of school for a holiday will be deemed unauthorised unless it is due to exceptional circumstances. An unauthorised absence of 5 days or more is subject to a Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN).

Should you still choose to take a holiday of 5 days or more then the Local Authority will be informed. A Fixed Penalty Notice will then be issued in accordance with section 444 of the Education Act 1996. The law stipulates that the current penalties payable by parents are £60 when the penalty is paid within 21 days and £120 when the penalty is paid within 28 days. This penalty is per parent/carer per child. If the fixed penalty is not paid this could lead to you being prosecuted in the Magistrates' Court.
