Autonomous	Robots have complete freedom to act independently of human control

Semi-Autonomous	Robots can act independently to some degree but still rely on some human input
Remote Controlled	Robots controlled from a distance by means of radio or infrared signals transmitted from a device
Cloud Computing	Using a network of remote servers hosted on the Internet to store, manage, and process data, rather than a local server or a personal computer.
E-Commerce	Commercial transactions conducted electronically on the Internet.
Video Games	A game played by electronically manipulating images produced by a computer program on a monitor or other display
Robotics	The branch of technology that deals with the design, construction, operation, and application of robots.
