Ancient Greece



Year 3 Learning Leaflet
Summer 2018

Our topic this term will focus on Ancient Greece, South America and Brazil.

In Science this term, we will be focusing on animals including humans. We will be looking at the different characteristics of animals and humans. We will also be looking more closely into the digestive system.

This year, we will deliver Art and DT in blocks at the end of the half terms. In Art we will be looking at Greek patterns and begin designing our own. In DT we will develop our skills in textiles by looking at the designs of masks and have the chance to create our own Brazilian mask.





In English we will be continuing reading Snow Dragon and learn to write stories with alternative endings. Towards the end of the term we will focusing our learning around play scripts. We will have the chance to evaluate scripts as well as creating and performing our own. We will also look at instructional writing and persuasion towards the end of the term.

In Maths we will be following the White Rose Maths scheme of work, which develops the children's fluency with number and their mastery at applying these skills to problems and puzzles. We will be focusing on measurement (perimeter) when we return and we will then move onto looking at fractions and time and then towards the end of the term we will begin to look shape. We will also continue to build on our recall of times tables.

In History and Geography we will develop our locational, place, human and physical geography knowledge. We will develop our map skills across different scales, locating countries and cities on a map. We will be focusing on Ancient Greece in comparison to modern day Greece and also South America and Brazil.



In Music we will have weekly sessions on a Friday afternoon. We will be following the Charanga theme which allows children to focus on each aspect of the musical curriculum. Our topic for this term focuses on Metal Stomp.



In R.E we will be learning about Islam, in particular about what Muslims think about God and why Mohammed (pbuh) is important to Muslims. We will read stories relating to the religion and discuss similarities and differences between Islam and Christianity.

In French we will continue to develop our

In Computing we will be looking at Data Handling.
