Year 6 Learning Leaflet
Summer 2024

In Science this term, we will be focusing on the topic of 'Electricity'. We will be identifying common appliances that run on electricity and construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs and switches. We will then be using the inspiration of the Titanic to carry out lots of different scientific experiments, using different materials and skills.

This term, we will have our final two blocks DT. In our first block we will be designing and pitching and underwater diving lamp, inspired by our English text and applying our Science skills. In our final block, we will design and create our own T-shirts, incorporating sewing, tie-dye or batik in our designs!

In English, we will be focusing on a book called 'Manfish'. We will be learning to use relative clauses, colons, hyphens and cohesive devices to make our writing flow. The end outcome of our unit will be to write a biography/hybrid text based around the book. After the half term, we will be reading the book 'Sky Chasers' this unit will be an opportunity for you to apply and practise all of your Y6 skills!

In Reading, we will be focusing our read and retrieve skills as well as our inference-based skills. These are very important skills to have to help us comprehend any texts that we read! First, we will focus on 'Great Adventurers' by Alastair Humphreys, followed by 'Sky Chasers' by Emma Carroll after half term.

In Maths, we will be finishing our maths teaching with the topic of Geometry (Looking at position and direction) and statistics. We will then be recapping past topics (such as long division, long multiplication, fractions and percentages) ahead of our SATs tests. Finally, we will work on projects that help to consolidate our learning and test our problem-solving skills.



Our Geography this term will finish our topic on South America, before moving to focus on revisiting our geographical based skills that you should have acquired through your time in school. We will focus on map-based skills, compass points and grid references.



In French, we will continue to develop our skills in conversational French including describing Café culture, restaurants and breakfast foods.



In Music, we will study different music genres including electronic and acoustic, look at pieces by different DJs, and compose our own raps. We will begin the unit with the song 'Something helpful' by Anna Meredith.

In RE during the Summer term, we will be focusing on some of the differences and similarities within Christianity locally and globally. We will also at Christianity and their belief in the afterlife.



In PE, we will be focusing on games style PE including adapted versions of rounders, and also other outdoor adventure activities. In the final summer term, we will focus on our athletic skills to improve flexibility, strength and balance.

In Computing, we will be using CAD systems to produce 2D and 3D models. We will then look at applying skills we have developed to create our own businesses!
