Dear Parents and Carers,

Can I start this letter by thanking all the parents who have attended this term's "Stay and Learn" sessions. I know it is not always easy to get time off work to attend but I know how much the children love having their adults in class with them. We still have our Yr3 and Yr6 sessions taking place this week. It is always great to see so many parents inside of school and I enjoy having the chance to read and share the lovely feedback – so thank you very much.

Talking about nice feedback, I was delighted to receive an email at the end of last week from Mr Farrington. Mr Farrington is a sport coach and he worked with us all last week as part of "Sports Week." In his email, he stated that:
