

Our topic will focus on Evolution and Inheritance. We will create links through our geography, science and English topics.


In **Science** this term, we will be focusing on the units 'Evolution and Inheritance' and also 'Animals including humans'. We will recognise that living things have changed over time and also look at how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment. We will also focus on the human body but specifically how the human circulatory system functions.

In **Art** we will be looking at still life of fruit (linking with illustrations from our English book the Selfish Giant). Focusing on the artist Paul Cezanne.

In **English**, we will be focusing on the book 'The Selfish Giant' by Oscar Wilde. We will be focusing on both past skills and new Year 6 skills. This will include new skills like passive voice, subjunctive verb forms and colons/semicolons.

• After the holidays we will be looking at the book 'The ISLAND' which will focus on similar skills and revisiting past skills such as cohesive devices.

There will be a major push on independent writing and ensuring that we proofread and edit our own work.



In **Maths** we will look at area and perimeter including calculating the area of triangles. We will then look at decimals and percentages. This will be followed by algebra in the final week. After half term we start to focus more on the SATs and covering areas such as statistics, ratio and geometry.


In **R.E**, the lessons will be based upon Sikhism and how Sikhs worship.

In **Music**, we will continue our lessons with me teaching which will be based on the topic, 'A New Year Carol' in Spring 1 and 'Classroom Jazz' in Spring 2.



In **P.E**, we will be continuing with our swimming lessons led by Mrs Baldwin.

Our **Geography** this term will be focusing on climate zones. Here will be look at climate zones of different countries specifically focusing on their vegetation, plants and animals.



In **French**, we will continue to develop our skills in French by learning numbers and months and also forming opinions about sports.

In **Computing**, we will be looking at digital media and designing our own digital 'How to Guide'.
