Humanist	A follow of the principles of humanism.
Atheist	Someone who doesn't believe in God or gods.
Reason	The power of the mind to think, understand and form judgements.
Theist	Someone who believes there is a creator God.
Empathy	To understand and share the feelings of others.
Agnostic	Someone who believes that we will never know for sure if God or exists or not.

- Humanists do not believe in God.
- Humanists only believe in the life there is - they do not believe in life after death as there is no scientific evidence.
- Humanists aim to live a true and happy life.
- Humanists believe we should use our human nature to decide how to live and find our purpose.
- Humanists rely on reason and evidence - they believe science should be used to know what is true or false.
