What software will we use?



images	a picture of a thing or person
text	a piece of writing. This could be part of a book, or writing added into something else, like a Pic Collage.
sounds	music, speech, and sound effects which are recorded and used in something
speech bubble	a shaped bubble added to a piece of work, with text inside which is supposed to be spoken
animation	making it look like drawings, models or objects are moving
voice recordings	speech which is recorded and added into a project or animation.
character	a person, animal or individual in a film, book or tv programme.
