Humanism is a World View. It is a system of beliefs which followers try to follow. It is different to a religion because Humanists don't believe in God. They believe in the importance of human beings, and believe that humans can still be good and kind without following a religion.	<ul> <li>Humanist - a follower of Humanism</li> <li>Evidence - facts or information which show that an idea is true or real</li> <li>The Golden Rule - a rule which helps Humanists decide what to do. See below.</li> <li>Curiosity - a strong desire to know or learn something</li> <li>Happy Human - the symbol of Humanism. It shows the main idea behind Humanism, which is that humans should aim to be happy and make others happy too.</li> <li>Celebrant - a person who performs a ceremony, like a wedding or a naming ceremony.</li> <li>Valuable - something which is special, or worth a lot of money. Something which someone thinks is very important is valuable to them.</li> <li>Unique - something which is one of a kind, there is nothing else exactly the same as it.</li> </ul>
