KEY IDEAS



The media can shape ideas around gender roles and identities.



Not everything we read or see on the internet is true. If it isn't true and we share it and talk about it with others we could be making more people believe something that is actually made up.

Phishing

The role or behaviour learned by a person as appropriate to their gender, **Gender Roles** determined by the prevailing cultural

The use of electronic communication to bully a person, typically by sending Cyberbullying messages of an intimidating or threatening nature

Giving the wrong idea or impression Misleadina

A person who is present at an event or **Bystanders** incident but does not take part

Fake news is a type of journalism that consists of deliberate misinformation **Fake News** or hogxes

Content on the internet whose main purpose is to attract attention and Clickbait encourage visitors to click on a link to a particular web page

Not easily convinced; having doubts **Sceptical** or reservations

Privacy is the ability to seclude **Privacy** information about themselves

A string of characters that allows access to a computer, interface, or **Passwords** system

> The fraudulent practice of sending emails from reputable companies in order to induce individuals to reveal personal information, such as passwords and credit card numbers
